

At a Glance: Alzheimer's Detection

ALZHEIMER'S DETECTION: A research team at the Columbia University School of Nursing will work with VNS Health to test an artificial intelligence tool that aims to detect Alzheimer's in clinical settings, the school announced Wednesday. Researchers published a \$1.2 million National Institute on Aging-funded study on the effectiveness of the tool, called ADscreen, in July. Now, VNS Health is beginning to enlist home care nurses to further develop the technology with patients.
