As clinical director of the nonprofit VNS Health's gender affirmation program, Shannon Whittington supports and trains home health clinicians caring for transgender and nonbinary patients following gender-affirmation surgery. She also plays a vital role in recruiting and training New York City clinicians, ensuring that patients undergoing gender-affirmation surgery receive expert care and feel fully supported during the experience. Whittington supports diversity, equity, and inclusion workplace initiatives at VNS Health, also sharing her expertise outside the organization to help others support LGBTQIA+ perspectives. She is also involved in a project studying the impact of post-surgical home care following gender-affirming surgery.
