Notable leaders from the Brooklyn and Chinese American communities joined with VNS Health on Monday to celebrate the opening of the home health care nonprofit's new Community Center in Sunset Park. The new center, which is one of three vibrant VNS Health Community hubs serving the Asian-American community in Brooklyn, Manhattan and Queens, aims to "tackle inequalities" in Brooklyn's Asian-American neighborhoods, and will be a place where seniors in Brooklyn can access culturally competent care, education, and connect with local health and social support resources.

Another new center opens in Flushing next Monday, Dec 12.
