

# McKnight's Announces 3rd Annual Pinnacle Awards Winners



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Thirty-two top flight long-term care leaders have been named winners in the 2025 *McKnight's* Pinnacle Awards program, organizers announced Tuesday.

An independent national panel of long-term care leaders chose the outstanding sector veterans, who are being recognized for driving change, setting new standards and inspiring others for at least the last 20 years. Nominations were made by peers and colleagues.

Some of the nation's most successful leaders in home care, skilled nursing and senior living are featured on the list. Honorees include veteran administrators, clinicians, caregivers, researchers and others from both for-profit and nonprofit entities.

"In many ways, this may be the most impressive field of winners yet," said *McKnight's* Publisher Craig Roth in announcing the honorees. "The competition was extremely close in most of the categories. It's a shame we couldn't have named each entrant a winner because, in truth, they've all been helping everyone around them 'win' at work for years."


